FAQs on Scotchgard Fabric Protector

What is this Scotchgard?

This is a kind of spray treatment which is done on the upholstery to protect it from any kind of liquid stains and dust.. Once the fabric is treated with Scotchgard, in case any liquid like tea coffe, oil, cola spills over on the fabric then will not get absorbed in the fabric. It will float on the fabric. It gives you ample time to remove it with a tissue paper and a dry cloth, so that it doe not leave any stain on the fabric.

Q) Does it protect from dust as well?

Yes it does. It does not allow the dust to pentrate into the fabric. Hence it can be easily removed by vaccum cleaning.

Q) Does the Scotchgard treatment laminate the fabric? Is it a kind of lamination?

No, it does not laminate the fabric. Even after treatment the porosity of the fabric is not lost. If it is laminated, then you will sweat underneath your thighs even in peak winter.

Q) What is the life of the treatment?

It depends on how well you maintain the fabric. On an average it last for 1-1½ yrs

Q) Do you provide cans or will your person do it?

We have both both the options.

Q) Does it change the colour / texture of the fabric?

No, you can touch the fabric and see it for yourself.

Q). Why are cushions charged extra?

If the cushions are fixed, then only one surafce is treated. If the cushion is loose, then for the same area, the treatment has to be done 3 times. (i.e. cushion both sides + sofa seat)

Q) How long it does take to do the job?

On an average it about ½ hour to do a 7-seater sofa. After doing the job it takes about 2 hrs for drying. During this period, even the smell of the chemical goes off.

Q) How much early do I need to inform you to get the job done?

Normally 1-2 days in advance

Q) How far can you go and do the job?

NCR. For outtstaion contracts, outstation charges are to be paid extra.

Q) Will it be effective even after dry cleaning?

The effectiveness reduces gradually after each dry cleaning and goes off after 2-3 dry cleanings
